




Types of Insurance Plans Offered




How are county health plans funded?

Counties with ≥1000 Full-Time Employees












How much are employers contributing (per employee/per year)?

What is the average amount that employees are contributing (per month)?




What is the average cost of co-pays for services?





What is the average cost of co-pays for prescriptions?














Summary

- PPO is most commonly offered health insurance plan, followed by HMO and High Deductible Health Plans (tied).
- Only 36% of counties offer health insurance to Part-Time employees (1.75x more counties DON'T offer health insurance to Part-Time employees)
- Self-funded plans are 2.29x more common than Fully-Funded plans
- Employers pay on average \$8,999/year (per employee)
- Majority of counties surveyed offer subsidized plans for spouses and family, but majority don't subsidize plans for retirees or retiree dependents
